
## Criminal Justice (Criminology) as a major

- For people that:
  - Value honesty, judgment, integrity, and a sense of responsibility
  - Are observant, analytical, enjoy investigations
- In this major, you will:
  - Learn to identify patterns of criminal behavior
  - Cover all facets of the criminal justice system: law, law enforcement, the courts and corrections
  - Study the processes for rehabilitation and treatment of offenders
  - Be introduced to the law, judicial philosophy, and the institutions of crime control in the U.S.



## Criminal Justice (Criminology) as a major

  - Counselor
  - Policy Analyst

### Criminal Justice at Texas State



## **Apply Texas Essays**

#### Essay A:

What was the environment in which you were raised? Describe your family, home, neighborhood, or community, and explain how it has shaped you as a person.

#### Essay B:

Most students have an identity, an interest, or a talent that defines them in an essential way. Tell us about yourself.

#### Essay C:

You've got a ticket in your hand – Where will you go? What will you do? What will happen when you get there?

## Writing your essay

- Dissect and answer the prompt
  - What is the prompt asking?
  - What does the audience want to learn about you?
- Make an outline
- Write a draft
- Proofreading, editing, and taking out fluff
- Tips
  - Remember: It's all about you! So make sure everything you say links back to something great about you.
  - Be specific, be focused, and tell a story
